- and further, the following Resolution, offered by Mr. Greenwood,
to appropriate \$2500, towards the erection of a Monument to
the Confederate dead.

Resolution.

'Be It Resolved by the Common & Select Councils of
the City of Norfolk, that the sum of Twenty Five Hundred
Dollars (\$2500) be and the same is hereby appropriated by the
City of Norfolk, to be applied with the money it has pledged
to the Pickett-Buchanan Camp, Confederate Veterans, for the
erection of a Monument to the Confederate Dead, to be placed
at the head of Old Market Square (Commercial Place) and
the proper arrangement of the Square, as per their Petition
under date of June 7, 1898.

The Finance Committee of the Councils is hereby
authorized and directed to borrow the sum of Twenty-
Five Hundred Dollars on Note or Bond of the City of
Norfolk, executed according to law, and at a rate of
interest not to exceed five per cent per annum for the above
named purpose.

The amount appropriated to be paid by the City
Treasurer on warrant or warrants of the City Creditor when
approved by the Chairman of the Committee on Monument
to the Confederate Dead.

The Rules having been suspended, the following
members voted aye on a motion to adopt the above
